Instructions for Importation of Personal Effects

You must provide CLEAR copies of U.S. Immigration documents or your U.S. Passport. This includes the visa and 1-94 and, as applicable, green card, work and/or work authorization card and/or stamps, temporary or permanent resident stamps in the passport, waivers, parole papers or any other documents that were issued to you upon entry into the United States.

A visa is invalid without an 1-94 and some 1-94's need additional papers to be considered valid. For example, a student needs a student visa, 1-94 and an 1-20.

Please note the **Supplemental Declaration** form is required with the **CF3299** for ALL personal effects and household goods entered. <u>DO NOT leave any items blank on the CF3299.</u>
